Agricultural Vehicles on the Roads

We have about 25 people booked in for the – **Evening Seminar with Mike Braithwaite - Thursday 13th March 2008. 6.30pm start.**

Intermediate and Advanced Food Hygiene Courses. (Level 3 and Level 4)

We have run the intermediate food hygiene course for members in the past. This 3 day course plus, an exam, is a level 3 course. The Level 4, 'Advanced' course is 6 days training, plus an exam, and includes two work based assignments as part of the course. In both cases the course days are delivered over a number of weeks rather than in a block. The intermediate course is one day per week and the Level 4 course would run over a period of several weeks.
